




The pedestrian trail of Vale de Cadela is a proposal to discover the rich local biodiversity framed by the various environments that surrounds Gouveia, in a 13-km circular path.

Starting at Bosque do Curral do Negro, the trail is accompanied by a series of information panels that allow a brief interpretation of the local biodiversity in four moments. After the Tapada de Sta. Cruz, the route heads to the bucolic Mata da Câmara, where the chirping of the seasonal birdlife mixes with the buzz of the Ajax stream that will accompany us, until the entrance to the city's urban perimeter. Until then, we can glimpse the ruins of old rotating mills and the Casa da Luz, reminding us of this valley's important role in the development of Gouveia, associated with the production of flour, but also with the production of energy that drove the intense local textile industry, which established itself as one of the most important in the country during the second half of the 19th century and the first of the 20th century.

Accompanied by an old water stream, which still feeds the agricultural fields built on the stream's slope, we reach the city's urban perimeter. We continue towards the Mata da Cerca dos Marqueses and cross its arcaded amphitheatre, to head to the Burrachota site, where the Gouveia Ecological Park and the CERVAS are installed, which warrant a lengthy visit, before starting the return climb technique to the Corral do Negro. Near the top, a belvedere allows you to catch your breath and soak in the multisensory experience, through observation, introspection or spiritual recollection, provided by the taste, smells and sounds of Nature framed by a superb view overlooking the River Mondego and the Beira Alta region.
